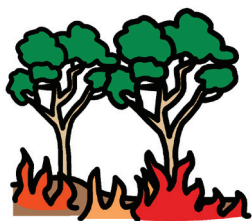

- be more confident about how to make safe decisions.



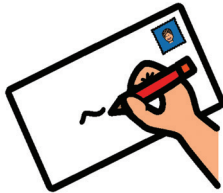


People who take part in Community Fire Safe groups are better

- after a bushfire.



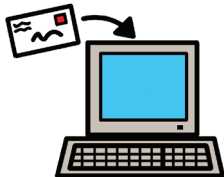

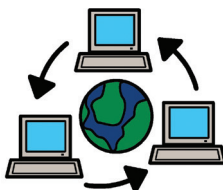
